



Towers on track

The major components of the Willogoleche Wind Farm are beginning to arrive onsite, paving the way for the erection of turbines in the coming months.

Towers, blades and other items are to be delivered daily, which will mean an increase in large vehicles on local roads.

Energisation of the substation that will feed the project's energy into the National Electricity Market will be undertaken in April, while the first of the 32 turbine towers is expected to be erected in early April.
