

Construction activity at the Willogoleche Wind Farm is set to increase in coming weeks.

This includes placing of demountable offices onsite, earthworks and developing an initial entry point off the Wilkins Highway.

ElectraNet has also begun works on the substation that supports the export of electricity into the national energy grid.

Once preliminary works are complete, roads will be constructed and hardstands built for each of the project's 32 turbines. These works are expected to take place between October, 2017 and February, 2018

Nearby residents can expect an increase in heavy vehicle traffic in the area and on the Wilkins Highway.
