New Mine Commissioner visits

Latrobe Valley Mine Rehabilitation Commissioner, Rae Mackay, met with Hazelwood's senior management team recently to outline his new role.

It was not the commissioner's first visit to Hazelwood. As a former member of the Technical Review Board, Professor Mackay is familiar with the Hazelwood Mine and senior Mine personnel.

Professor Mackay briefed management noting that his role was to ensure the rehabilitation of the Latrobe Valley mines following the end of their life and ensure the mine operators undertook necessary and appropriate levels of community engagement.

He highlighted the three key aspects of his work as the establishment of a framework for monitoring and planning/progress of rehabilitation, community engagement and research.
