COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Will the public have further opportunities to be involved in what happens to the Hazelwood site?

ENGIE Hazelwood understands the community interest around Hazelwood and we are committed to continuing consultation after the official closure date of 31 March 2017. Our consultation process over the years has included open community forums, advertising in the Latrobe Valley Express and on commercial radio, information displays in public places such as shopping centres, direct mail and website postings. We understand that rehabilitation of the site is a significant issue for the Latrobe Valley community and will continue to provide ongoing information through all these channels.

If the Hazelwood site is eventually handed back to the community how can we have a say on what will happen to it?

There will be a range of opportunities after closure for community input and feedback, and we will engage extensively with the community over all final rehabilitation concepts. We understand how important it is for the community to be actively involved in any future plans for the Hazelwood Mine's rehabilitation.

Can we continue to get information as decommissioning of the Station and rehabilitation of the Mine progresses?

The company will provide regular updates on the progress of decommissioning as well as remediation and rehabilitation of both the Station and Mine through ongoing community engagement. We will also have a designated project section on our website where the community can find out about all aspects of the project. This will be regularly updated.

How do you intend providing the community with this ongoing information?

ENGIE Hazelwood has, on a number of occasions, canvassed the community to gauge the preferred method of receiving information. To ensure everyone is informed, we will continue to use a range of avenues, which may include:

- Regular advertising in the Latrobe Valley Express newspaper
- Open letters to community published in the Latrobe Valley Express



- Lift-out information sheets inserted in the Latrobe Valley Express
- Fact Sheets



- Paid advertising on Gippsland commercial radio
- News articles published in the Gippsland print and electronic media
- Public displays set up in major shopping precincts and manned by staff



- Open community consultation forums
- A dedicated section containing information in closure, decommissioning and rehabilitation on the ENGIE in Australia website



- Videos
- Emails
- Regular briefings of key community leaders and Gippsland politicians.
