### Turbine House powers off

Power has been disconnected from the Hazelwood Power Station Turbine House as part of ongoing decommissioning activities.

Once supplying over 25 per cent of Victoria's electricity through the national grid, the last remaining auxiliary lighting in the Turbine House was turned off for the last time on 28 February when supply from the grid was cut.

With planned Station decommissioning activities on schedule and almost completed, there is little need for any personnel to enter this area. The disconnection means the area which houses the turbines and control rooms is now in total darkness.

The Turbine House is locked and secure, with perimeter lighting of the Power Station block remaining live for safety and security purposes.

When access is required to the Turbine House or surrounding buildings, a 'safe site access' procedure is in place to ensure the safety at all times of our employees and contractors.
