### Heritage Consultants commence assessment

Heritage consultants have begun their on-site assessment of ENGIE Hazelwood's buildings, equipment and other items.

Lovell Chen, a multi-disciplinary practice with more than 30 years' experience in architecture and heritage, has been engaged by ENGIE to undertake the works.

Heritage team principal Kate Gray said the firm combined architects and designers with heritage consultants, planners, conservation specialists, historians, researchers, materials experts and other specialists in aspects of the built environment.

After Lovell Chen completes their assessment, ENGIE Hazelwood will consult with the community and organisations such as Heritage Victoria, historical societies and Latrobe City Council to determine the most appropriate and respectful way to acknowledge the contribution Hazelwood made to the Latrobe Valley community and the State.
