Milestone in Station decommissioning

Station decommissioning at ENGIE Hazelwood achieved a significant milestone this week, with the one millionth litre of oil being removed from the site.

Station Director, Wayne Buckley, said one million litres was “an incredible” amount of oil to be removed from the site and all work had been carried out safely.

“Approximately 65 per cent of this volume originated from our transformers with the remaining 35 per cent drained from the turbine generator lube oil systems,” Mr Buckley said.

“Further oil removal will occur as part of the remaining decommissioning work, however this amount represents the majority of oil disposal being planned.

“The decommissioning program is ahead of schedule and remains on track for completion in late April, 2018.”
