Redundant pipes removed from Hazelwood Mine

Works are continuing on removing the redundant fire service pipework from the Eastern Batters.

The old clean water and dirty water fire services pipes have existed for many years and have provided fire suppression water and allowed dewatering activities to continue for this period.

These pipes have been thoroughly tested over the years and have survived a range of extreme events, most recently the 2014 mine fire.

As the Knuckle Pipeline Realignment Project has been completed and the extensive system of new pipes installed, the redundant pipes can be removed to allow rehabilitation of the batters to continue.
