Topsoil spreading for Eastern Batters

Topsoil spreading along the Hazelwood Mine's Eastfield Eastern Batters started this week.

These batters are in the area of the Mine visible from the Princes Freeway.

The clay-capped area is part of 10 hectares to be covered in topsoil by Christmas. It will be seeded at the end of summer.

The topsoil is being trucked from Northfield and will be spread using bulldozers.

As part of this Eastfield Eastern Batters Rehabilitation Project, heavy plant is also modifying a haul road for the trucks to have easy access to the area.
