### This was some of the feedback...

- 'Provide a landscape around a lake which provides benefit to the community and is very accessible'
- 'Recognise and enhance the environmental potential of the site, providing an opportunity for local flora and fauna to flourish'
- 'There must be no risk to the community and no health issues from demolition'
- 'Use materials from the site to build an iconic structure with the name of all employees, including their contribution'
- 'Establish an entire glass lookout where the Power Station's history could be projected onto the landscape via the glass'
- 'Have a section of the rehabilitated site for outdoor recreation, sports and accommodation'
- 'Support a diverse range of future uses and enhance environmental, recreational, lifestyle, tourism and other community initiatives'
- 'Provide a safe environment with no potential asbestos contamination and water contamination'
- 'Create a lasting legacy which provides an attractive community resource'
