Eastern Batters Rehabilitation progresses

Rehabilitation of Hazelwood Mine's Eastern Batters is progressing.

This is the area of the Mine that can be seen from the Princes Highway, adjacent to the Morwell township.

Earlier this year, a significant amount of work was completed removing overburden to access the coal below so reshaping of the coal could commence.

Now a significant area has been reshaped and is in the process of being covered with overburden, using two large bulldozers.

The area around the 'Southern Outlet' is being reshaped to its final design rehabilitated profile.

The fire service system has now also been relocated, with the 'Knuckle' replacement pipelines being completed last week.

This area once contained conveyor belts which used to transport coal from the East Field, South West Field and South East Field mine developments to the Station.

Work has also started this week on removing the redundant fire service pipework so rehabilitation can continue in the area.

This removal work is being undertaken using internal and external resources.
