### Hazelwood equipment sale

ENGIE in Australia is committed to the safe and sustainable decommissioning of the Hazelwood Power Station. This includes the removal of surplus equipment not required for demolition works.

ENGIE Hazelwood is in the process of engaging a heritage consultant to identify items of cultural and architectural heritage significance at the site.

We will then consult with the community and organisations such as Heritage Victoria, historical societies and Latrobe City Council to determine the most appropriate and respectful way to acknowledge the contribution Hazelwood made to the Latrobe Valley community and the State.

The equipment for sale in the initial auction phase includes furniture such as chairs, tables, desks and cabinets, office equipment, white goods, tools and some large machinery.

Liquidity Services, a specialist company in industrial sales, has been contracted to run the sales process. The first online auction is planned for 7 September.
