

Details Feed-In Electricity

New South Wales: Market feed-in tariff (voluntary feed-in tariff)

Eligibility

The market feed-in tariff that we voluntarily offer customers will only apply to you if:

- you have entered into a market retail contract with us; and are not part of the New South Wales Solar Bonus Scheme
- the generation facility at your Premises:
 - is a solar photovoltaic generator, a wind turbine, or other renewable energy generator that has a generating capacity of no more than 10 kilowatts;
 - is installed and connected to the distribution network in a manner that provides for all the electricity generated by the generator to be supplied to the distribution network and allows the relevant distributor to measure at any instant the amount of electricity supplied; and
 - complies with and is installed and connected in a manner that complies with, any safety, technical or metering requirements that may be prescribed by the applicable regulations or market operations rules.

Feed-in Tariff Rates

If you are eligible for the current feed-in tariff:

- for each kilowatt hour of electricity you generate and export back to the electricity grid, we'll credit you 8 cents per kilowatt hour, (GST if applicable); and
- your feed-in electricity credits will appear on your electricity bill.
