

Details Feed-In Electricity

New South Wales: Solar Bonus Scheme (regulated feed-in tariff)

The Solar Bonus Scheme Tariff is not available to new applicants.

Eligibility

The Solar Bonus Scheme Tariff will only apply to you if:

- your Premises is already assigned by your distributor to the New South Wales Solar Bonus Scheme; and
- the generation facility at your premises is a complying generator.
 - A generation facility is a complying generator if it:
 - is a solar photovoltaic generator, a wind turbine, or a renewable energy generator of a class prescribed by the applicable regulations, that has a generating capacity of no more than 10 kilowatts;
 - is installed and connected to the distribution network in a manner that provides for all the electricity generated by the generator to be supplied to the distribution network and allows the relevant distributor to measure at any instant the amount of electricity supplied, and
 - complies with and is installed and connected in a manner that complies with, any safety, technical or metering requirements that may be prescribed by the applicable regulations or market operations rules.

If at any time you are no longer entitled to a regulated feed-in tariff for your feed-in electricity, whether because you cease to be eligible or the relevant scheme ends or otherwise, then we will instead credit you with a voluntary feed-in tariff no less than the voluntary feed-in tariffs included in offers for feed-in electricity we are making in the market at that time.

Feed-In Tariff Rates

If you are eligible for the Solar Bonus Scheme feed-In tariff:

- for each kilowatt hour of electricity you generate and export back to the electricity grid, we'll credit you \$0.08 per kilowatt hour or \$0.60 per kilowatt hour (as determined by your distributor), exclusive of GST; and
- your feed-in electricity credits will appear on your electricity bill.
