

Modern Slavery Contract Clauses

Consultancy Services Contract

20. Modern Slavery

- (a) In performing its obligations under this Agreement, the Consultant must, and must ensure that each of its subcontractors and suppliers that are engaged in connection with this Agreement will:
 - (i) comply with all applicable modern slavery laws, regulations and codes, including but not limited to the *Modern Slavery Act* 2018 (Cth) (**Modern Slavery Law**);
 - (ii) take all reasonable measures to implement an appropriate system to ensure compliance with any Modern Slavery Law including due diligence, audit and training;
 - (iii) immediately notify the Principal if it becomes aware of any breach of this clause 20;
 - (iv) comply with any direction given by the Principal to ensure compliance with any Modern Slavery Law; and
 - (v) keep appropriate records evidencing the reasonable measures taken to ensure compliance under sub-paragraph (ii) and provide these records to the Principal on request.
- (b) The Consultant represents and warrants that:
 - (i) it is not aware of any "**Modern Slavery**" (as defined in the *Modern Slavery Act 2018* (Cth)) in its, or any of its subcontractor's or supplier's, operations or supply chains; and
 - (ii) neither it nor any of its officers, employees, subcontractors or suppliers (or its subcontractor's or supplier's officers or employees):
 - (A) have been convicted of any offence involving Modern Slavery; or
 - (B) have been or is the subject of any investigation, inquiry or enforcement proceedings by any governmental, administrative or regulatory body regarding any offence or alleged offence of or in connection with Modern Slavery.
